Paul Duerden has lived the volleyball dream. Selected to the National Team directly from high school, Paul trained to the limit everyday, and reaped the rewards by being called the best player in the world. Along with starring for Canada for 16 years, Duerden, an opposite hitter, enjoyed a brilliant professional career in Europe, playing in France, Germany, Belgium, Italy, and Turkey. In his 14 years as a professional, Paul was able to win all 4 European Cups (named MVP in 3 of them) including the most prestigious of them all, the Champions League. Steve Brinkman was a mainstay on the Canadian national senior men's team for 17 years, backstopping a powerhouse squad world-renowned for its blocking prowess. A teammate of London's own Paul Duerden, Steve competed in over 300 international matches for Canada. Brinkman, a middle attacker/blocker, also enjoyed a lengthy professional volleyball career, competing around the world, including in France, Italy, China and Russia, and winning both the prestigious World Club Championship and European Cup Championship. Steve is an Assistant Coach with the McMaster University Men's Volleyball Team.
